Most of our Newsletters are sent to a special group of people who have expressed a desire to receive special "inside" information about flying saucers - information which we consider "too hot to handle" in our regularly-scheduled issues of SAUCER NEWS.

This Newsletter, however, is being sent to all our subscribers and to the dozens of other people who have written in during the past few months. Your Editor has been unable to attend to personal mail since last November, and for this reason many rumors and unanswered questions have been making the rounds. Let us hasten to assure our many faithful fans that we are not "hushed up" nor is the magazine about to fold.

The truth is that until very recently your Editor was in business in South America, and for the past several years he has been attempting to publish SAUCER NEWS every three months, even while being away as long as four or five months at a time. Usually, in spite of everything, we managed to keep pretty nearly on schedule, but this time we have really fallen behind. The March issue, which ordinarily would reach you in late February, is now being prepared, and will be mailed out some time in June. The June issue, which should be on the press about now, will not appear till at least July. After that we will be back on schedule regarding the issues dated September, December, etc.

The business which has caused us to be out of the country so much, has now been terminated. This will give us more time in the future to attend to saucer research. Many of you have asked us what the nature of our business in South America is, or was. We are still not ready to reveal this information, except to state again (as we have done many times before), that it has nothing whatsoever to do with flying saucers. Nor is it true, as some of our wilder fans have claimed, that your Editor is a secret agent of the Air Force, the CIA, or what-have-you. At the moment we only wish to state that we will soon be writing a book which will clear up the entire "mystery" of our South American activities. More details about the book will be given out in SAUCER NEWS from time to time.

We were really heartened by the tremendous response to our Literary Contest, as described in the December 1960 SAUCER NEWS. Unfortunately there is such a volume of articles piled up here in our Headquarters, that we will probably not be able to announce the results of the contest until the June issue. We hope you will bear with us until that time.

Meanwhile we still have made no final arrangement regarding the sale of more than 7,000 saucer clippings (advertised several times in SAUCER NEWS). These clippings cover the years 1954-1961, and would make an invaluable contribution to the files of any researcher. Anyone who is interested in this offer should contact us immediately.
